

The re-evaluation report should be presented in the format of the comprehensive report sent to the Institution. It should include:

- 1. Each concern raised in the comprehensive report send to the Institution;
- 2. The response of the Institution to each concern raised;
- 3. The adequacy and appropriateness of the response of the Institution to each of the concerns raised as presented in the response document from the Institution and the revised curriculum;
- 4. The conclusion with regard to the entire revised programme, which should address the following aspects:
  - a. Is the curriculum prepared in the format provided by the Commission for Higher Education?
  - *b. Is the curriculum clearly written and void of editorial, both typographical and grammatical, errors?*
  - c. Are the various components of the curriculum linked to each other?
  - d. Is the programme appropriate for the type of field and level of students intended?
  - e. Is the programme contextualized and relevant?
  - f. What are the major areas of concern in the curriculum?
  - *g.* What is your overall recommendation of the programme? Does the programme need to be further revamped or *re-designed*?
