Note: Most abstracts will include the objectives, methods, results and conclusions of the research project. However, we realize that this format does not apply to all research projects, and more reflective-type abstracts will also be accepted.

When submitting the abstract or paper, the following Sub-Titles need not be stated but can be used as a guide
